UC Merced opened in 2005 with 875 students



Our students are diverse, Californian and first generation The campus has grown to 7,900 students

72% are among the first in their families to attend a four-year university



55% majoring in science, technology engineering and math

99% of undergraduates are Californian



- 7,375 Undergraduates (Fall 2017)
 - 29% from San Joaquin Valley
 - 28% from Los Angeles County
 - 22% from the Bay Area
 - 592 Graduate Students (Fall 2017)

The campus features modern, high performance buildings and more than 1.4 million gross square feet



Virtually every building is certified LEED Gold or Platinum
