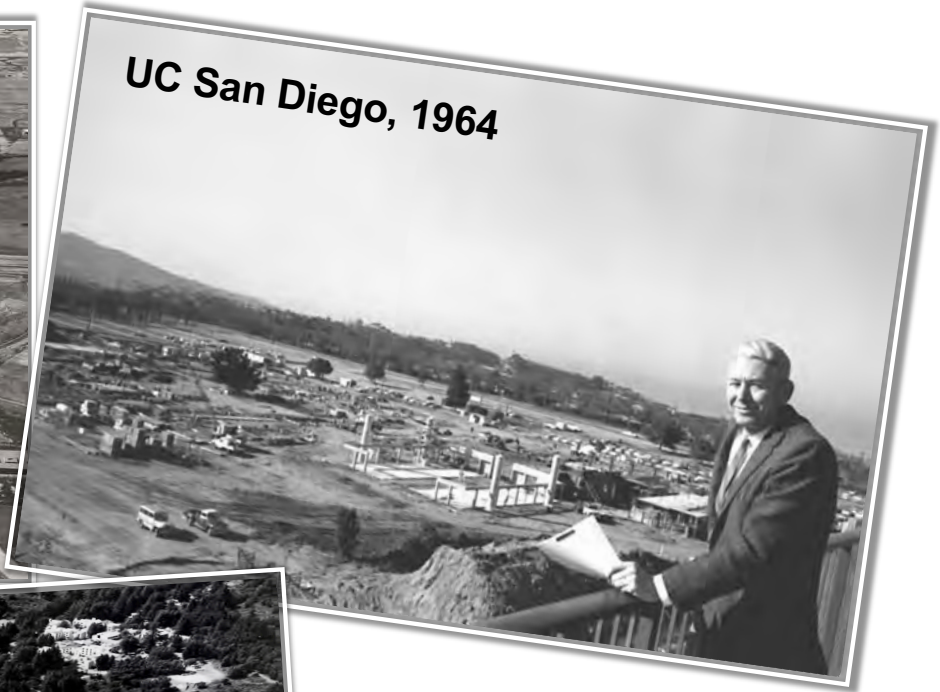

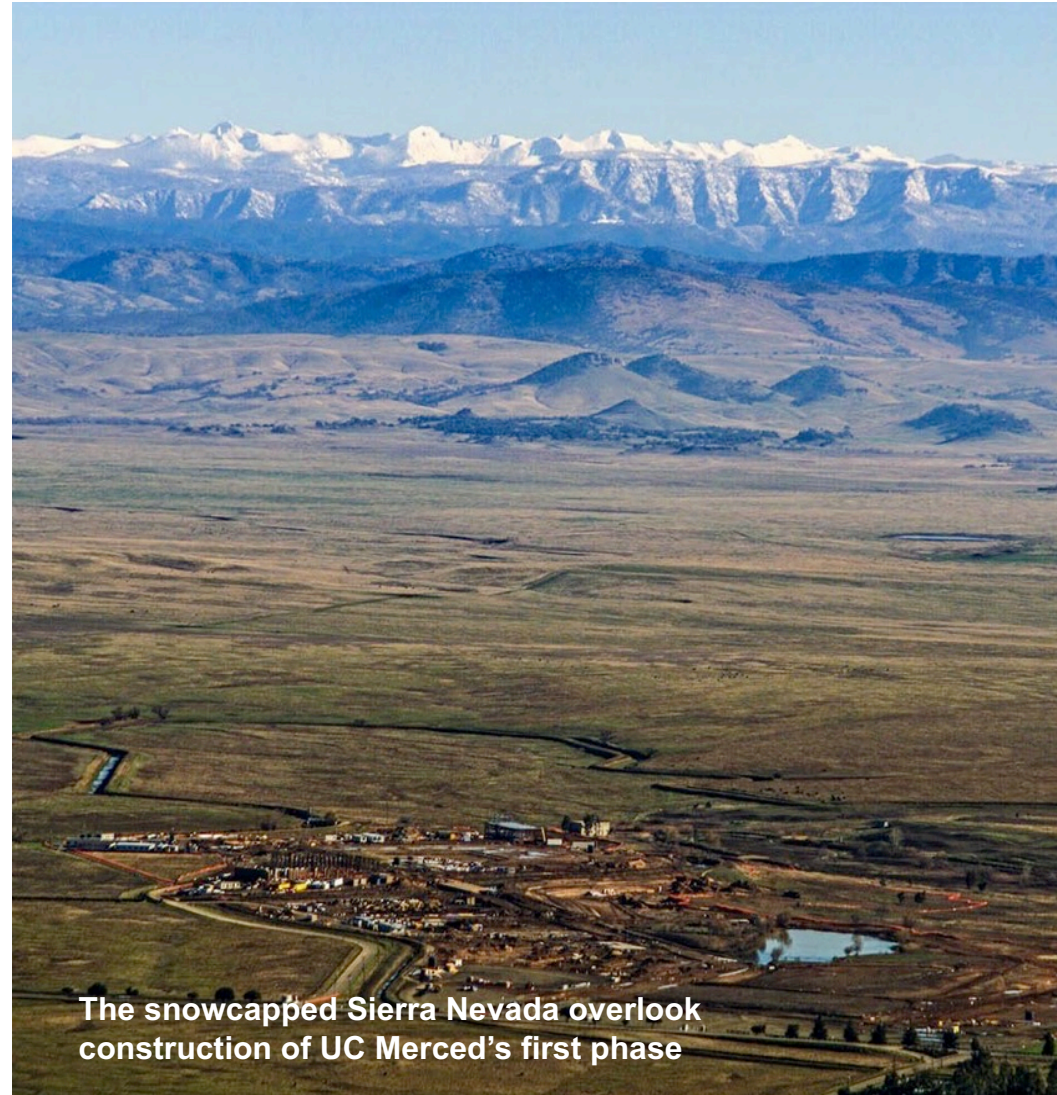

55% majoring in science, technology engineering and math

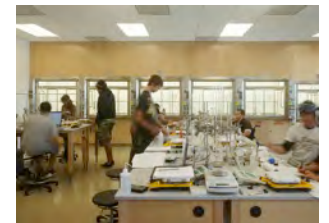
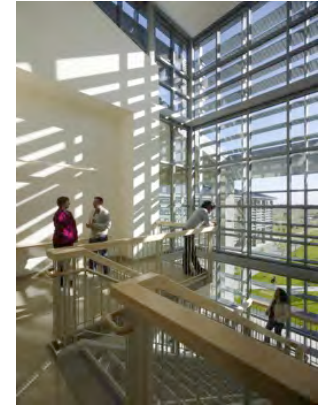
99% of undergraduates are Californian

in the San Joaquin Valley**

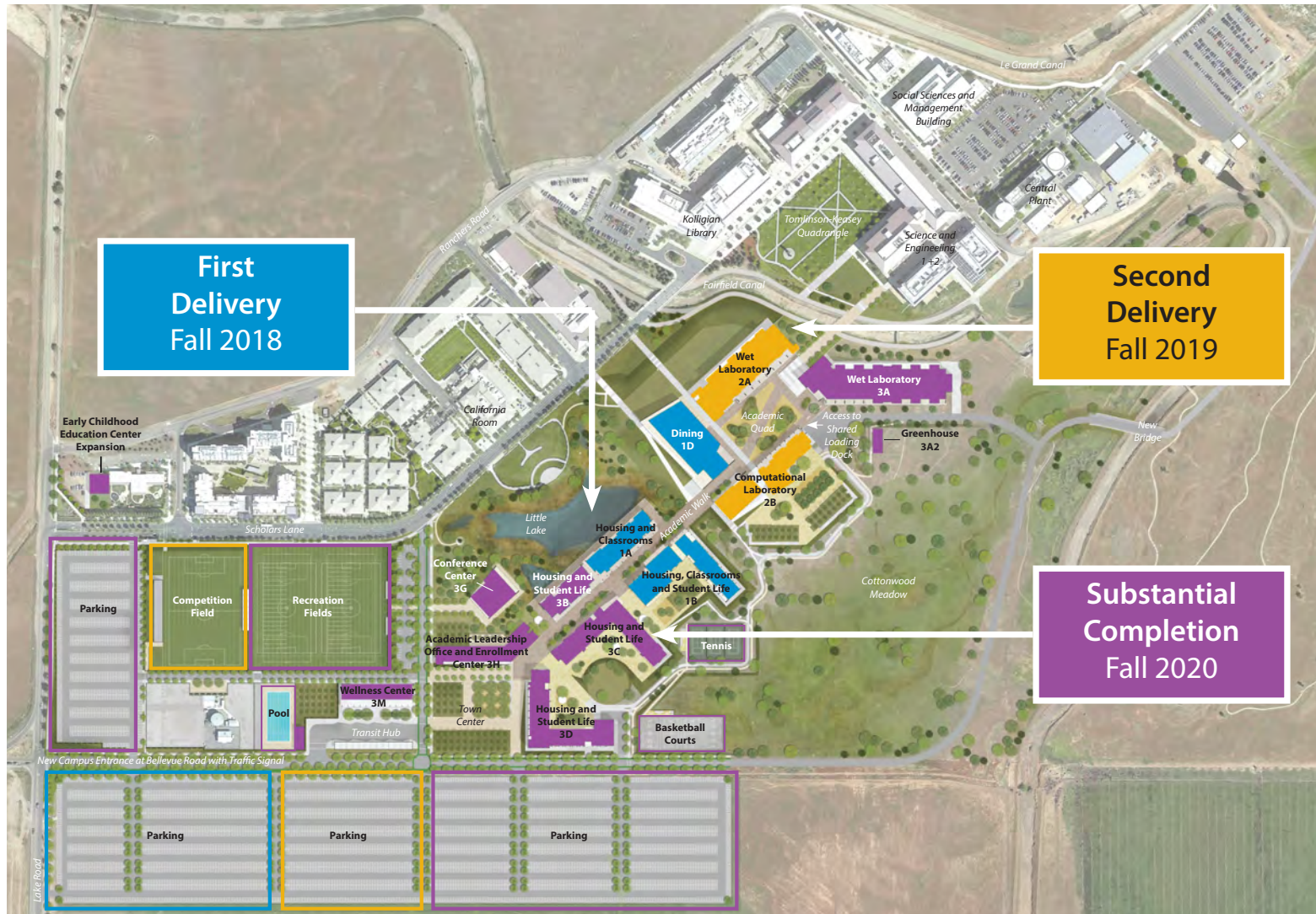


The campus will double in physical size  
February 2018 Aerial View



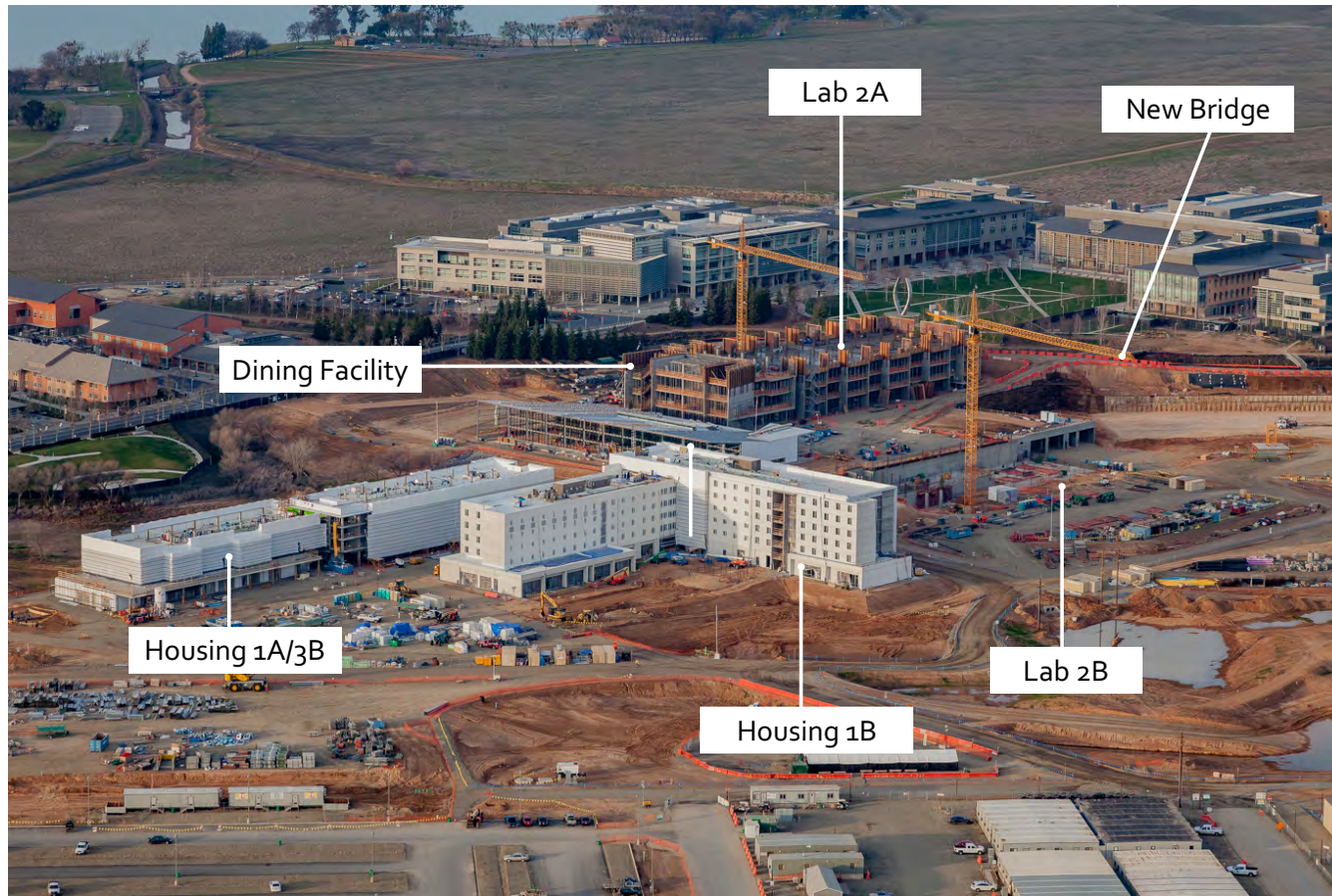


# The project is being delivered in three phases
